- I. Meeting was called to order by Staci Welch at 4:00. Ms. Welch welcomed everyone and thanked them for their input and participation on the School Advisory Council for 2017-2018.
- II. Committee Chairs presented updates.
 - a. **ELA (Reading/Writing) – Notes from meeting presented by Amber Allen for Kelly Mitchum.**
 - Teachers are pleased with i-Ready
 - Would like to look at AR Rewards and including one for meeting goals each nine weeks – possibly a certificate at the End of the Year Awards Assembly/picnic
 - Would like for ELA resources to align to FSA
 - Can some test prep materials be purchased through the school?
 - Would like to see district required read-alouds that align more closely with Social Studies Standards
 - b. **Math – Presented by Brandi Panzarino**
 - Final STAR test results dropped – Is it possible to use the 3rd assessment?
 - Feel that it might be beneficial to only test 3 times and no STAR testing after FSA
 - Teachers like Moby Max, but miss IXL
 - Concerns over STAR alignment to grade level standards
 - Students become frustrated
 - c. **Science – Presented by Renee Kelly for Debi Morgan**
 - Need to focus on scientific vocabulary throughout grade levels
 - Use Interactive Science Notebook
 - AIMS
 - Would like to have trainings on Inquiry Based Science Instruction
 - Field trips were beneficial
 - STEM Materials were purchased and utilized throughout the school
 - Ms. Burse will try to incorporate Science into Media rotations to review previous years' standards for 5th graders
 - Clarification of the role FCAT Science plays in school grade was given by Mr. Hernandez

d. Technology – Presented by Heather Hatfield

- Concerns regarding STAR alignment
- Primary would like to get STAR FALL back
- Max Scholar for ESE – consensus is that i-Ready is more beneficial
- Teachers would like IXL back
- Most teachers are utilizing Class DoJo or Remind to inform/communicate with parents
- Hear Builder license ran out – Kindergarten would like to get it again and some 1st grade students as needed

e. Parent Involvement – Presented by Amber Allen

III. End of Year Data review – Presented by Ms. Welch and Mr. Hernandez

a. Attendance Goal

- Power Point Presentation
- 78 total students with excessive absences – 14% absences which is down from 19% last year

b. Science Goal

- Power Point Presentation
- 5th grade average for the end of the year is a 84%

c. Reading Goal

- Power Point presentation
- STAR Break Down for Proficiency 50th percentile or above: 1st – 64%; 2nd – 65%; 3rd – 60%; 4th – 71%; 5th – 51%
- STAR FSA prediction : (Levels 3,4,5) 3rd – 74%; 4th – 71%; 5th – 62%
- Kindergarten STAR Early Literacy – 60.7 % Transitional Readers; 15% - Probable Reader – an explanation of these terms was given
- 1st grade STAR Early Literacy – 26.9 % Transitional Reader; 71.8 % Probable Reader

d. Math Goal

- STAR FSA prediction : (Levels 3,4,5) 3rd – 67%; 4th – 59%; 5th – 56%
